GRAND CRU ROSACKER Riesling



Our Organic wines are made in accordance with principles of organic farming, which excludes the use of artificial chemical fertilizers, pesticides, or

herbicides. The goal is to produce quality wines and valuing the expression of one's terroir, promoting positive interactions between soil, climate and plants. The organic approach is the logical outcome of a process of environmental protection, appreciation of the capacity of the terroir and the development of a very typical product.

History & Terroir

Rosacker is among the most celebrated of Alsace's Grands Crus vineyards, with descriptions of its wines dating back to 1483. It owes its name to the wild roses, which grow in abundance around the edge of the vineyard. The limestone soils here produce Rieslings that are bone-dry yet which have a rare richness and mouth-filling texture. With great complexity and balance this Organic wine will easily age for two decades.

Wine Tasting

Rosacker owes its name to a wild rose bush. The wines produced on these hillsides have the same refined composition of purity and complexity. Rosacker Riesling is pure and complex, marked by a strong personality. it leaves a long lingering finesse in the mouth.

It's a lieu-dit which gives full-bodied touches to the wine with its exuberance and structure. The finish of this Grand Cru is subtle and distinct, giving these singular wines an almost never-ending length!.
